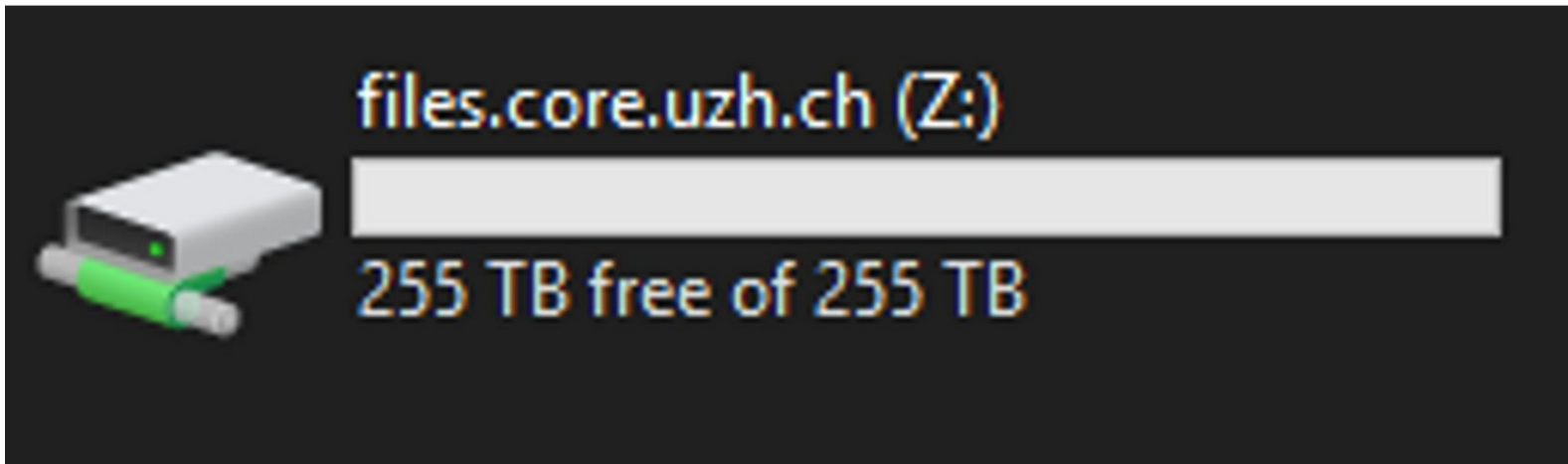


Access your data - only external via FTPS

INTRODUCTION

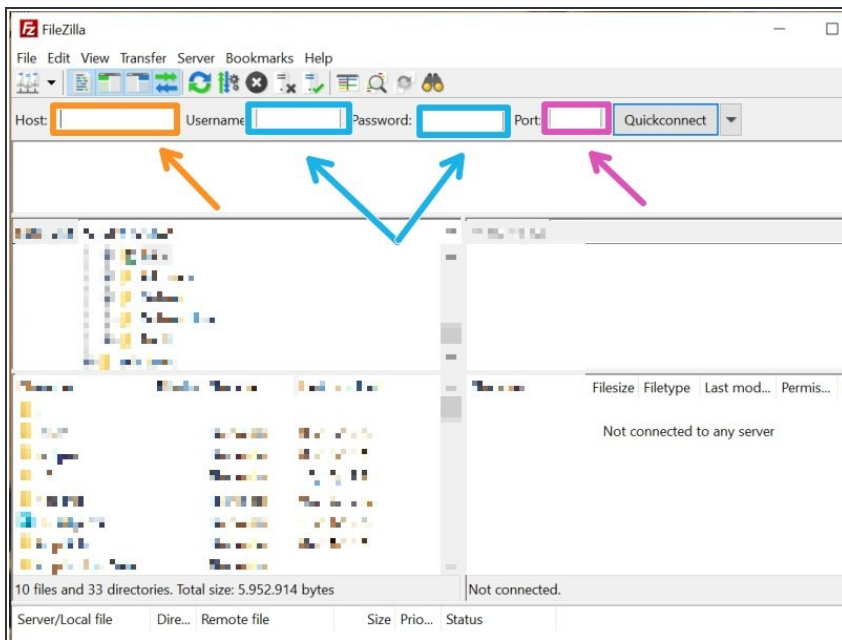
This solution only works when connecting from an external network (not when working from within the UZH network).

Step 1 — Install FTP client

- To connect via FTPS it is necessary to install a FTP client software, for example [Filezilla](https://filezilla-project.org/).

Step 2 — Connect to server



- In the FTP client, specify the server address: **ftps://ftp.core.uzh.ch**
- Use your CORE account credentials to connect to the server.
- The port is: **990**
- Your FTP client software will ask you to verify the certificate. If it mentions ftp.core.uzh.ch and if its issued by the University of Zurich / DigiCert everything should be fine.

⚠ Please be aware that you only have read access to the ftps server (no upload, modification or deletion of files is possible).

⚠ Access from within the UZH network is not possible via FTPS.
